Swachh Survekshan January 20th to 22nd, 2017

The Swachh Bharat Mission was officially launched on 2 October 2014 at Rajghat, New Delhi, by Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi which aims to eradicate open defecation and management of Municipal Solid Waste by 2019, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is a national campaign, covering 4,041 statutory cities and towns. It is India's largest ever cleanliness drive with 3 million government employees, and especially school and college students from all parts of India, participating in the campaign.

In order to foster a healthy competition between cities for improving cleanliness standards, the Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) started the "Swachh Survekshan" survey, ranking of cities on cleanliness and other aspects of urban sanitation, in 2016 which ranked 73 cities across the country. On the same lines, MoUD has initiated "Swachh Survekshan" 2017 which has conducted survey to rank 500 cities of India. Our City Pathankot is also one City among 500 Cities to participate in Swachh survekshan 2017. Dr. N.K. Singh AMO (H) is the Nodal Officer of Swachh Bharat Mission in Municipal Corporation Pathankot. Municipal Corporation Pathankot have successfully participated in Swachh survekshan 2017

The performance evaluation of the Swachh survekshan is conducted by Quality Council of India (QCI), an autonomous body established by Government of India. A team comprising of two surveyors visited Pathankot on 20th January' 2017 for the survey of Swachhata, which was concluded on 22nd January. During this period, the team visited different locations of the City where on the spot checking was made, depending upon the different parameters of MoUD. After that, the team went through the detailed documentaion as per the Questionnaire of Swachh survekshan 2017, directed by the Ministry of Urban Development. After that, the team interacted with the Public and submitted the citizen feedback to the MoUD, in which they asked people about:-

- a.) if people are aware of the survekshan being held.
- (b.) if people are aware of the Dust Bins kept across the road side.
- c.) if people are aware of the Door to Door collections in their respective wards.
- (d.) if people are aware about the Public Toilets in their wards.
- e.) if people were satisfied with the electricity and water in the public toilets.

After going through there questions and a long time of interaction, finally they submitted the survey reports for the survekshan accordingly.
